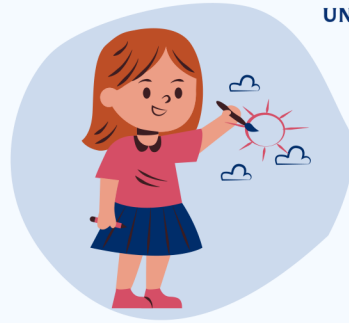


WANT TO LEARN MORE ABOUT PLAY & PWS?
